

**Parental Consent for Students Walking to and from school:
2011-2012 School Year**

The Montessori School at Holy Rosary acknowledges that students who live within the neighborhood of Little Italy and/or those utilizing the Alta House facilities for after school hours may be granted parental consent to sign themselves in and out of school. Students who are the equivalent of fourth grade or older may be responsible for bringing to or taking a younger sibling from the school premises upon signed consent from the parent. **This privilege extends to siblings only.** Students who are walking are expected to arrive to school on time and will be dismissed at the end of the regular school day. They are expected to follow all safety precautions in their travels and go directly to their pre-determined destination (home or Alta House).

will be walking to school in the morning and may sign him/herself in at the classroom. Students may not sign in to the classroom prior to 8:15 a.m. and may not be loitering in the hallways prior to that time. Students who need to be at the school earlier than 8:15 a.m., therefore, must be enrolled in the before care program.

I further give permission for my child(ren) names above to be dismissed as a “walker” at the end of the school day. (Indicate with an asterisk next to those children who are 4th grade or older.) Students who are in primary or lower elementary will not be dismissed until the older sibling has signed them out. Students are expected to follow all school rules in regard to behavior in hallways and on school property.

The school reserves the right to restrict a student’s “walking” privileges in the event of safety or behavioral concerns. Parents will be notified immediately of these concerns.
